

NOTICE OF INCREASE IN FEES

From the Summer term 2022, the fees for music lessons with Mrs Julie Doubleday will be increased to:

- £17 for a 30-minute lesson
- £25.50 for a 45-minute lesson
- £34 for a 60-minute lesson

This is in line with the Incorporated Society of Musicians (of which I am a member) and the Musicians' Union guidance for music tuition in the north of England. More information can be found on their websites.

I have not increased my prices for many years and believe that my fee represents excellent value for money compared with instrumental teachers of the same calibre and with the same expertise and experience.

This equates to the following termly amounts:

- 11 x 30 minutes individual lessons (weekly) = £187 per term
- 6 x 30 minutes individual lessons (fortnightly) = £102 per term
- 6 x 45 minutes individual lessons (fortnightly) = £153 per term
- 11 x 30 minutes joint lesson (weekly) = £102 per person per term *

** This is subject to availability, if two students are willing and able to share lessons. Otherwise, the student can receive 6 lessons per term for the same price or pay for individual weekly lessons.*

Please note that any lessons owing from the block or term previous, will be charged at the old fee.

I offer in addition to instrumental tuition at no extra cost:

- No charge for piano accompaniment, examination support and tuning of instruments for viola/violin students, or examination support for piano students at ABRSM examinations (or any other music board)
- Unlimited printing of any extra music I wish the student to learn
- Unlimited access to personalised how-to videos, accompaniments, performances and practice videos on my YouTube channel – I spend a lot of time creating videos for all my students to use in their practice sessions
- Theory of music tuition as part of your instrumental instruction
- Support for students with school projects, school examinations, orchestras, bands and other musical endeavours (eg. GCSE compositions, primary school class projects)
- Organising live or online concerts for all my students at least once a year

AND

- NEW! I will provide A4 display folders for each student (except for First Access students) to keep their music, information sheets and music theory sheets in (if required)
- NEW! I will provide each student with a small manuscript book and provide them with regular activities to do in these books (eg drawing the clefs or composing a tune)
